Minutes:

- Welcome and thanks from Chair, Pat Radford.
- Prioritising traffic problems and concerns for Letterston. Bethany Lloyd from PLaned read out a letter from the Trunk Road Agency which have examined the collison data for Letterston beteween 1.7.10 and 30.6.13 and conclude that Letterston does not have a problem. However Dyfed Powys Police can be asked by the County Council to monitor traffic speed at specific times and be told where to place cameras. Pat Raford has spoken to the head at Letterston School about this concern. Concern was generally raised re the existance of a Walking Bus for the school and lack of safe crossing over the A40. Pat suggested devising a petition for the Community on this area. Bethany Lloyd suggested that Letterston and Wolfscastle work together on this problem. It was pointed out that the A40 is under the jurisdiction of the Trunk Road Agency and St Davids Road, Station Road etc are under the County Council. It was suggested a letter go to the Trunk Road AGency stating we are pleased they are looking into our concerns and we would like to be kept informed. Re the possibilty of petition: suggested that Tom Richards (County Councillor) be contacted in time with aims.
- Appointment of Committee Members Voted on Jean McCarthy, Lawrie McCarthy, Rosemary Murphy and Stuart Miles. Apologies from Irene Hart, SUe Thomas and Babs Johnson who may be interested.
- Questionnaire for the youngsters and elders of our our community was discussed to ask them what they would like in the village. Drop off point for completed questionnaires could be Sue and Russell's shop.
- Facebook page was seen as a good idea. The name to be 'I <3 Letterston' maybe?? Involve the youth group on this. Would need at 3 administrators.
- Friendship group at present the luncheon club meets on Weds. run by volunteers. Questionnaire could be given out again to ask folk what they would like to see

happening in the village.

- AManda Miles suggested a newsletter in time could be a good idea to keep all residents informed of activities and news etc. Liz CArtwright suggested Sue Thomas may be part of the editorial team for this. In the meantime it was thought that a flyer would be a good idea to let everyone know about the Weds Lunch club, the Over 60's club at Wolfscastle, Pembs Voluntary Transport etc.
