

Letterston Memorial Hall have recently been awarded a grant of £2,000 from the Comic Relief Grant VSEF, administered by the PAVS Supporting Community Action Fund Panel. This money is to support preparations and maintenance of the hall during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The amount will cover 'cloud' spray treatment every month, a process that sterilises everything in the hall – walls, floors, furniture, doors, windows etc. Additionally there is a manual cleaning regime set up to follow each hiring or use of the hall and equipment used.

Extra locks and other minor changes allow use of the main hall which will be isolated from users in other meeting rooms.

The hall has been open to a small number of users already and will be again when rules allow it.

Hall users and hirers can book space for approved activities, provided that they prepare a risk assessment for their activity and maintain secure use and access for their group. The responsibility is with the user (not the hall committee) to ensure their activity complies with rules from government and local authority that are in force at the time. This includes Track and Trace.

The hall committee have done careful planning and preparation to help hirers to keep everyone safe.
